The Day County Board of Commissioners convened in regular session at 9:00 AM, Friday September 11, 2020 in the Commissioners Chambers in the Day County Courthouse. Meeting called to order by Chairman Tompkins. Members present: Commissioners James, Tobin, Sinner and Walters. Others: Auditor Fosheim, Amanda Fanger-R&F, Sheriff Rucktaeschel, Glenn Gebur and Jim Walter.

PLEDGE: Chairman Tompkins led the members in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES: Moved by James, seconded by Sinner to approve the minutes for September 1, 2020 regular commissioner meeting. Motion carried.

2021 BUDGET HEARING: The commission conducted the 2nd Budget Hearing for the 2021 Proposed Budget. Register of Deeds Berger discussed with the board increasing her Modernization & Preservation Fund by \$5,000.00. She also discussed the need for a part-time person in her office. Moved by Sinner, seconded by Walters to increase the 2021 Modernization & Preservation Fund from \$10,000 to \$15,000. Motion carried. Moved by Walters, seconded by James to increase the 2021 Register of

Deeds Budget from \$165,107.00 to \$190,297.00 for a part-time person (up to 25 hours/week). Motion carried.

GOVERNOR'S COVID CARE MONEY: State Legislators Steve McCleerey and Susan Wismer along with Jennifer Keintz met with the board for suggestions on what to use the Governor's Covid Care money for.

RECESS: Chairman Tompkins declared a recess at 10:32 AM. Chairman Tompkins reconvened the regular session at 10:39 AM.

HWY DEPT. BID/PURCHASE EQUIPMENT: Moved by James, seconded by Tobin to approve Hwy Supt. Braaten to bid on and possibly purchase a 2012 140M2 motor grader through Girard Auction. Motion carried. Moved by Sinner, seconded by James to approve Hwy Supt. Braaten to purchase a sand spreader from Northern Truck Equipment at a cost of \$17,825.00. Motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT: At 11:00 AM, moved by James, seconded by Tobin to adjourn until 9:00 AM, Tuesday September 22, 2020 to convene in the Commissioners Chambers in the Day County Courthouse. Motion carried.
