The Day County Board of Commissioners convened in regular session at 9:00 AM, Tuesday March 13, 2018 in the Commissioners Chambers in the Day County Courthouse. Meeting called to order by Chairman Tompkins. Members present: Commissioners James, Tobin and Hesla. Others: Ray Erku-R&F. Absent: Walters.

PLEDGE: Chairman Tompkins led the members in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Frank James discussed with the board the complaints from concerned citizens in Farmington, Union and Homer townships about their assessed values.

TAX SALE PROPERTIES: Treasurer Wagner presented four properties up for the Tax Sale. Two in Bristol City (71.03.02121, 71.11.0301 & 71.06.00A2) and two in Andover Town (70.03.0201 & 70.06.0020). Moved by Hesla, seconded by Tobin to deed the properties to Bristol City and Andover Town. Motion carried.
