The Day County Board of Commissioners convened in regular session at 9:00 AM, Tuesday March 5, 2019 in the Commissioners Chambers in the Day County Courthouse. WATER PROBLEMS: Darrel Waddle reported that the water pipe was repaired after no water for six days at the courthouse and jail. CDJ Electric Plumbing and Heating, Britton, SD said the water line coming into the courthouse should be replaced soon. The commissioners all agreed to get it repaired.

SHERIFF DEPT. Sheriff Rucktaeschel reported they are cleaning up in the jail and some prisoners did some painting.

HEATING AND PLUMBING REPAIRS: Sheriff Rucktaeschel reported that six baseboard heaters were replaced in the jail. There are also some plumbing issues that need to be fixed. Moved by Sinner, seconded by Tobin to authorize the Sheriff to hire CDJ Electric Plumbing and Heating, Britton, SD to repair the leaky toilet and replace 12 flush valves at an estimated cost of \$2,300.00. Motion carried.

TRAVEL REQUEST: Moved by James, seconded by Tobin to approve travel expenses for Courtney Tedder to attend a Conference on SD Sex Offenders Registry in Deadwood, SD on April 30 & May 1, 2019. Motion carried.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE LICENSE HEARING: Moved by James, seconded by Tobin to approve the transfer of the alcoholic beverage license for Clausen's Steakhouse (Kurt Clausen) to PLL, LLC (Alicia Gauer) Hilltop Steakhouse LLC for the 2019 licensing period. Motion carried.

CONCERNED CITIZENS FROM GRENVILLE TOWN: Tamara Lesnar and Mike Gonzales from Grenville Town appeared before the board. Their concerns are that the county snow plow goes through the Town at an excessive speed and doesn't stop at the stop signs. It also pushes snow up blocking their car in and the snow is flying in their yard and on the car. The Hwy Supt. will tell the driver to slow down and stop at the stop signs. Another concern is the water is not draining properly through the culvert along their property. It will end up flooding their property. The Hwy Supt. will look at it in the spring.
