WHEREAS, cities and towns in Day County may be rescinding or withdrawing or staying their business restrictions; and

WHEREAS, Day County contends that restrictions on businesses and events are still necessary, however, in light of steps being taken by cities and towns that Day County's enforcement of the Ordinance may be problematic, now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that enforcement of Day County Ordinance No. 2020-01 effective March 30, 2020 at 12:00 a.m. will be stayed, meaning it will not be enforced by County unless the County by subsequent resolution rescinds this Resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED that if businesses elect to re-open it is recommended that they follow national, state and industry guidelines to ensure safety of employees and public and Day County is not recommending reopening but leaving it up to businesses to decide on efficacy of reopening.
