RADIOS: Bob Rajchel with Communications Management Group spoke on behalf of rebuilding the portable radio system within Day County. Rebuilding the radio system would eliminate 2 channels on the 911 system, so Emergency Responders are only having to change between 2 channels instead of 4 and would grant better coverage in some of southern Day County. Moved by Kjos, seconded by McGregor-Okroi for Bob Rajchel to see what the cost would be and keep moving forward with the radio project.
